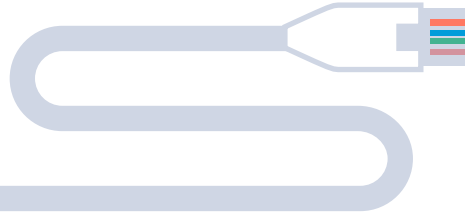


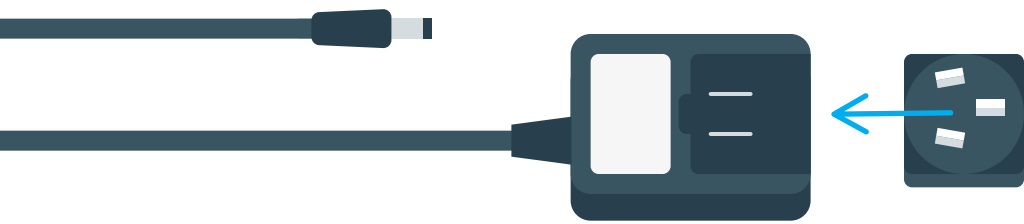
1. What's in the Box

Check to ensure you have the necessary parts; which should include:

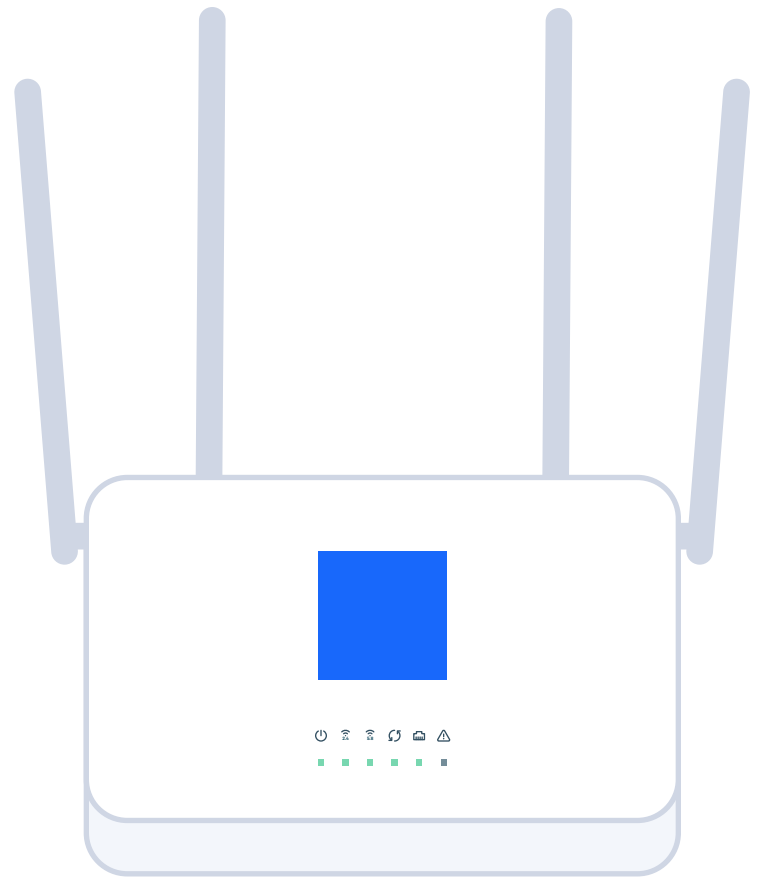
1x **Ethernet cable** (1m)



1x **Power supply** (plug requires assembly)



1x **Whitebox**

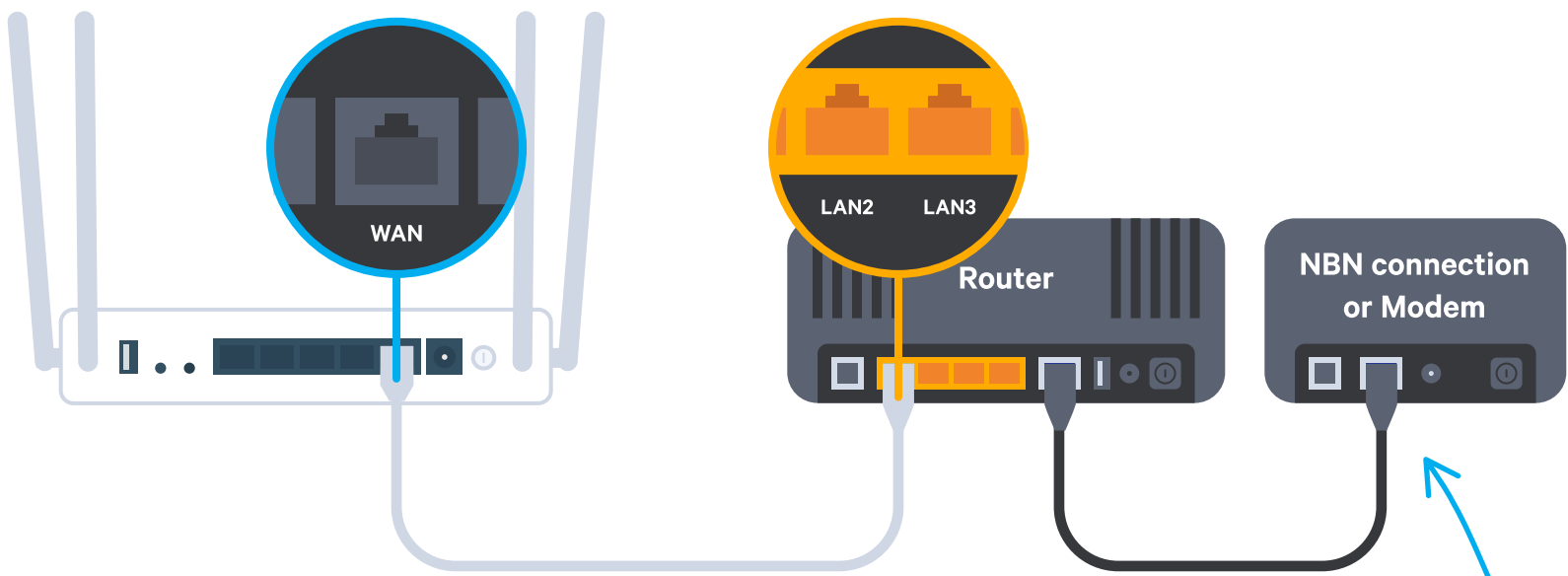
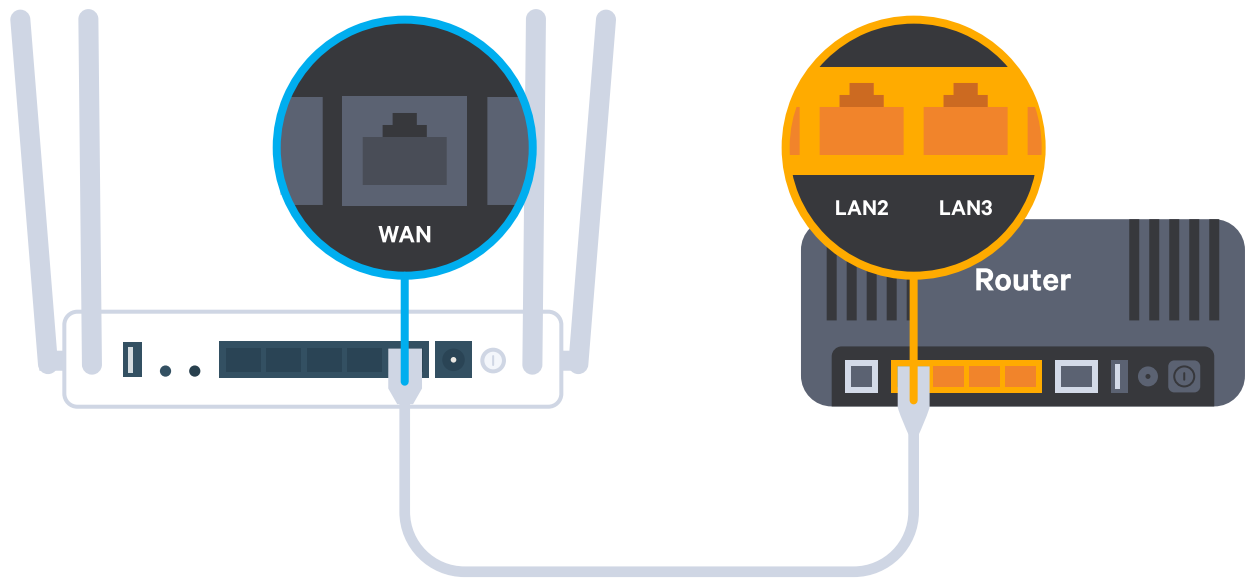


2. Connect

If you have a combined modem / router

Plug one end of the **ethernet cable** into the port marked **'WAN'** on the back of the Whitebox.

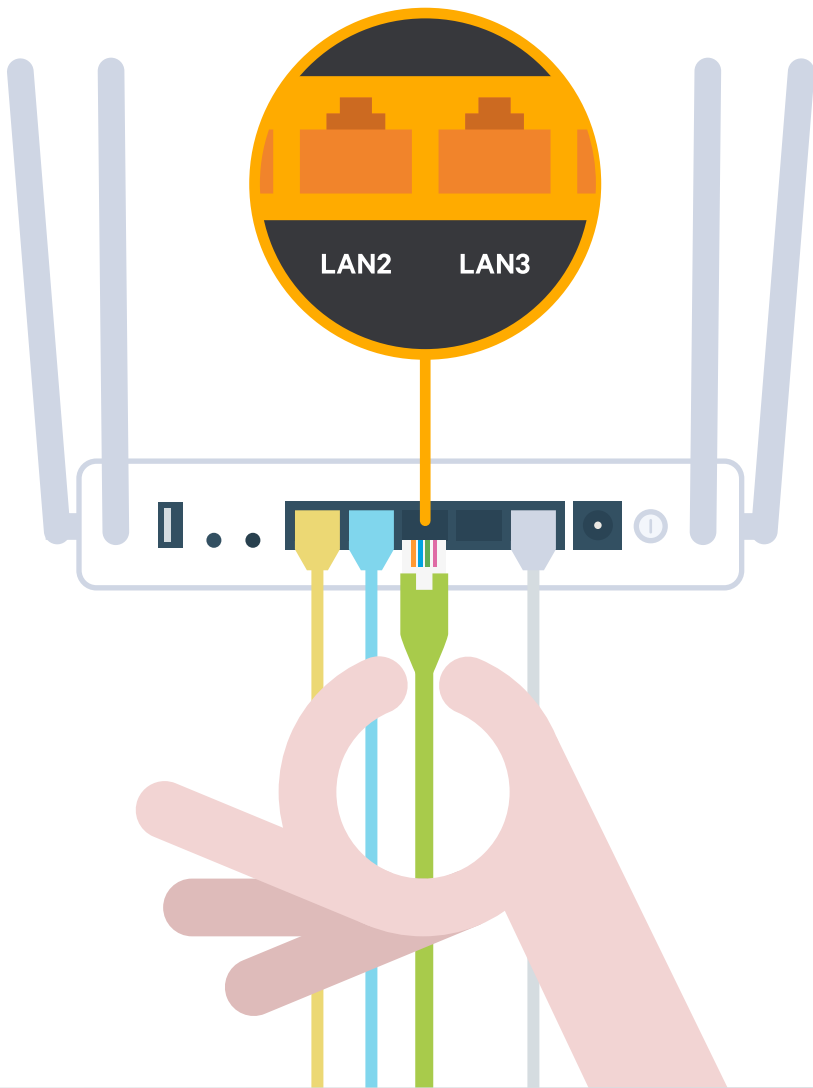
Connect the other end of the ethernet cable into a spare **'LAN'** port on your combined modem / router.



Leave as usual

If you have a separate modem and router

Keep your NBN connection or modem connected to your separate router as usual.




3. Plug in wired devices

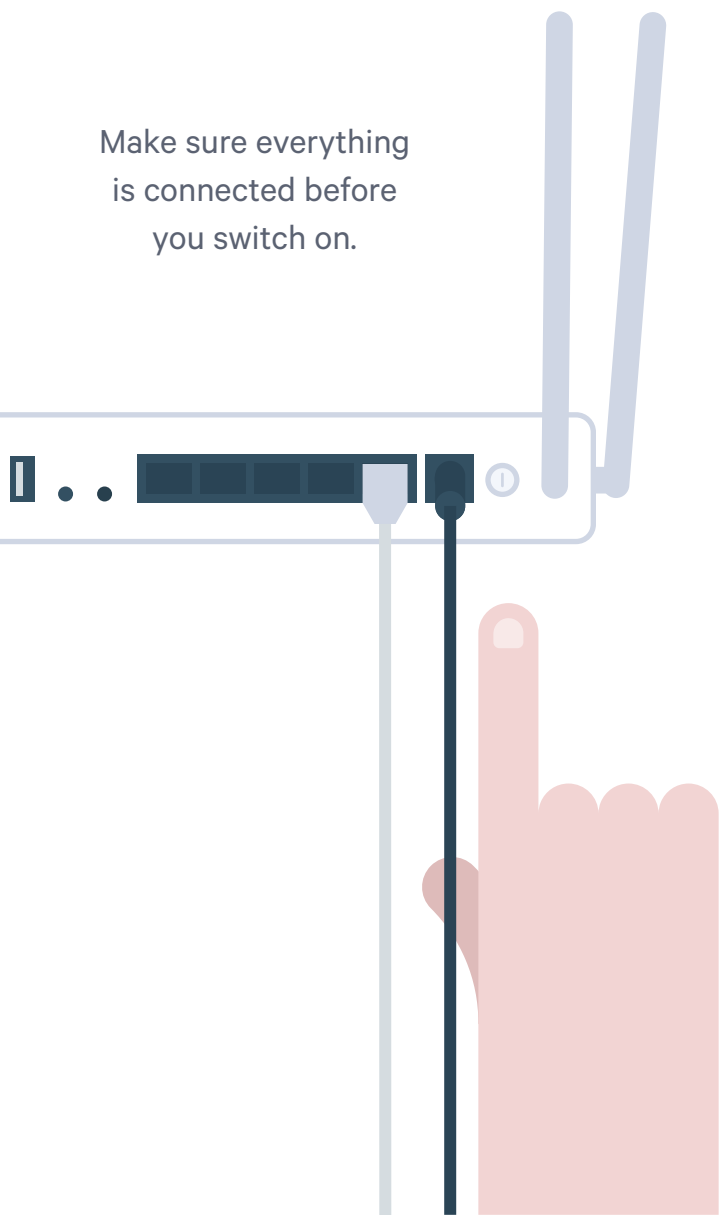
Disconnect any other wired network devices from your home ADSL / cable router. Plug them into the ports marked **'LAN1 to LAN4'** on the rear of the Whitebox. (Please note the USB port is non functional)

4. Power up

Connect the **power supply** to your Whitebox. Switch on at the mains socket, then press the button on the back marked **'ON/OFF'**.

When the light below the  icon remains steady the Whitebox is fully set up.

Make sure everything is connected before you switch on.



5. Log in

Your Whitebox is now ready to start testing your internet performance. You can directly login into nbn-nielsenpanel.com to check the status of your account.
